

Dear Commanders and Commandresses,

Here is the updated dress code from the Rules and Regulation changes.

Re: Rules and Regulations

#15 a) Inappropriate or offensive clothing (*see addendum aa*), **body piercing** (*which during competition(s) should be removed to avoid any injuries to ones self or others, may be worn during free time*) **that could possibly occur during an event, hair style/color and/or tattooing** (*temporary or permanent, which needs to be covered during competition(s), not free time*) **by any participant at the Slet may result in possible point deduction(s). This will be determined by the Physical Fitness Board.**

(aa) Inappropriate clothing: Shirts/tops: *mid drifts, belly or ½ tops (just make sure that bellies are not showing, especially when at rest or not lifting the arms-common sense please), tub tops, see through tops (unless a top is underneath), shirts with any advertising or home school, etc, logos larger than 2 inches.*

Shorts/skirts: *short shorts- anything that reveals any part of the bottom, shorts with writing on the backside of the shorts, shorts with any advertising or home school, etc, logos larger than 2 inches on the front leg. If your shorts are rolled down at the hip area, be aware that if any Physical Fitness Board member feels that the shorts are too short, the*

participant will be asked to unroll them so that they are of a more appropriate length. At any time throughout the Slet, a Physical Fitness Board Member can request that the participant(s) change, cover, or turn inside out clothing that they feel is inappropriate using these guidelines. If your participant refuses to follow these request(s), then a meeting will be held by the Board Members to determine the participant or group consequence(s).

#15b) At the coaches meeting on arrival day, any questionable items, (with reference to 15a), needs to be brought forth. At this time, the Physical Fitness Board will determine eligibility.

There was a question of what kind of clothes could or should be worn during free time. Clothes that meet the above guidelines will be OK!! You do not have to wear team clothing all week unless your group elects to do so. Wearing old uniforms (such as an old basketball, volleyball, softball, track/field etc.) is sometimes a favorite to wear.
